1. On the last date of hearing i.e. 22.05.2025, the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner has filed the instant 2nd petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16 dated 08.02.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 74, 126(2), 351(2) & 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Earlier, the anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner was dismissed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, vide order dated 21.02.2025. Thereafter, the petitioner had approached this Court by filing petition bearing CRM-M No.11431 of 2025 seeking grant of anticipatory bail which was also dismissed vide order dated 01.04.2025 by passing a detailed order. Now, the petitioner has filed the present 2nd petition for grant of anticipatory bail without any change of circumstances.
