1. It would be noted here that the petitioner has died. Despite repeated opportunities, learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to bring his legal representatives on record.

2. The petitioner herein was a tenant who was ordered to be evicted by the Rent Controller in a petition filed under Section 13-B of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949. It has come on record that the tenant-late Sh. Amarjit Singh migrated to a foreign land. He appeared through his attorney, namely, Sh. Sarwan Singh, his brother. He never appeared in the Court to contest the petition.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.



4. Hence, the revision petition is dismissed.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
