Prayer in the instant writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to re-issue/release the passport against the earlier passport No.K-5121284 dated 26.04.2013 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for respondents/UOI, at the outset, submits that the instant writ petition has become infructuous as the passport of petitioner has already been dispatched to her.

3. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
