**YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of F.I.R. No.11 dated 13.2.2019, registered under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Offence under Section 307 IPC stands deleted and charge framed under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC) at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. This Court vide order dated 2.8.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements

recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 28.8.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioner(s), are hereby quashed.
