**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.45 dated 23.08.2024 registered under Section 420 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 23.08.2025 by way of an affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur, District Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on

instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.07.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
