Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.48 dated 26.07.2024 under Sections 75 of BNS and Section 8 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Cantt. District Bathinda.
