AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 18.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1416 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“ *In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.4 i.e. the Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division No.2, Sri Muktsar Sahib to examine the claim of the petitioner in the light of a legal notice dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) that is stated to have already been served by the petitioner and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight*

Needless to observe that in case, any amount is found due, the same would be released to the petitioner without any further delay.”

Learned State counsel has filed reply alongwith Annexure R-1 i.e. the order dated 01.05.2019, in Court today. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for petitioner.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order has been complied with, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, if there is any grievance against the order dated 01.05.2019, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
