MANISHA BATRA, J. (ORAL)

1. This is the second petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of FIR No.207 dated 08.10.2023 registered under Sections 326, 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. This Court vide order dated 28.05.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise. Respondent No.2 has died during the pendency of the present petition.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judge has submitted



report dated 07.07.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.207 dated 08.10.2023 registered under Sections 326, 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) are quashed qua the petitioners.
