Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, Assistant Registrar (Legal), Office of DSE (SE), Punjab, who is present in Court, submits that a detailed speaking order, in terms of the decision dated 30.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Education Tribunal, Punjab, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner on 06.02.2025 at 11.00 a.m. in the office of Director, Secondary Education, Punjab, shall be passed within a week from that date and a copy thereof shall be forwarded to the petitioner within a week thereafter.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
