1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to take strict necessary legal action against respondents No.5 to 9 on the basis of statement recorded of petitioner in GD No.16 dated 08.02.2025 at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) and to direct the police officials to take action against respondents No.5 to 9.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that GD No.16 dated 08.02.2025 at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur has been registered however, no action has been taken on the same till date by the investigating agencies.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. He, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, has submitted that Sections 115(2) and 3(5) of BNS have been added and the necessary action has already been taken on the same.
