The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 483 (3) BNSS, read with section 528 BNSS, for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent no. 2 by this Court vide order dated 18.07.2024 in CRM-M 20683-2024 (Annexure P-2) in F.I.R. No. 0069 dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420/406/120-B IPC and Section 13 Punjab Travel Professionals, P.S. City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

In compliance of the order dated 11.03.2025, affidavit dated 27.03.2025 of Sh. Sartaj Singh Chahal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner today in Court.

Mr. DPS Bajwa, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and filed his Power of Attorneys, which are taken on record.
