Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the order dated



22.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-8775-2024 titled as “Charanjeet Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others” whereby the petition was disposed of with a direction to “...to the respondents to decide the demand notice dated 20.03.2024, Annexure P-6, within a period of six months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.”

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to agree with the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners, he seeks to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to take recourse to any other remedy available to him, as per law, if any.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Rule stands discharged.
