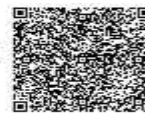

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6 and to decide representation dated 24.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) that has already been filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner raising his grievances which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, learned DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the

paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 24.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
