**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)**

1. In the present petition, the challenge is to the order dated 04.02.2016 (Annexure P-21) passed by the District Magistrate under the Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 by which, the petitioner was asked to vacate the premises on the asking of the respondent No.3-senior citizen (father).

2. By a detailed order dated 19.09.2016, the dispossession of the petitioner-son was stayed and unfortunately, respondent No.3-senior citizen on the asking of the whom the petitioner-son was asked to vacate the premises, has died on 04.03.2018.

3. Once, the respondent No.3-senior citizen has expired, the order dated 04.02.2016 (Annexure P-21) giving direction to the petitioner son to

vacate the premises so that the senior citizen can live peacefully, the same are no longer required to be complied with as the respondent No.3-senior citizen is no longer in this world.

4. The present petition is disposed of with the observation that as the respondent No.3-senior citizen has died, the impugned order dated 04.02.2016 (Annexure P-21) be not given effect to any further.

5. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
