1. Present petition has been filed seeking direction to official respondents for conducting free, fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.224 dated 11.05.2025 under Sections 115(2), 296 and 351(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station Zirakpur District SAS Nagar (Mohali) as the same has been filed against the private respondents and their accomplices by completely ignoring the allegations and evidence of actual offences of attempt to murder, grievous hurt, armed robbery/snatching in conspiracy with each other.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been seriously injured at the hands of accused in the above mentioned FIR, which has been registered by the petitioner. He submits that the Investigating Agency has intentionally lodged the FIR for simple injuries whereas the injuries are more grievous in nature. He submits that for the redressal of his grievance, he has filed a representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.3 but the same has not been taken into consideration.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He submits that the case is under investigation.

5. After hearing counsel for the parties and in view of the statement made by learned State counsel to the effect that the case is under investigation, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to take into consideration the representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner along with the evidences adduced in support of the same and conclude the investigation in accordance with law in a free and fair manner. However, petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedies as available to him under the law, in case, any further cause of action accrues.
