HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has been issued appointment letter with her deemed date of appointment as 05.09.2024 and she shall be made to join in terms of the appointment order. He further submits that the petitioner shall be granted notional benefits including fixation of pay etc.
2. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
3. It is made clear that in case needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her

own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application, if any.
