**N.S.Shekhawat J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.06 dated 12.03.2025, registered under Sections 7, 7A, 13(1)(b), 13(2) of P.C. Act read with 215 of BNS, Police Station ACB, Hisar.

2. The FIR in the present case was registered on the basis of the statement made by Pooja daughter of Sh. Kurda Ram and the same has been reproduced below:-

*“To, The Inspector, Anti Corruption Bureau, Hisar, Sir, It is requested that I, Pooja daughter of Sh. Kurdaram, am a permanent resident of village Sahnewala, Tehsil Tosham, District Bhiwani. I joined the job as Female Supervisor in the Women and Child Development Department, Bhiwani on 30.11.2024. I have a Citizen*



*NPS account. My department has sent my Citizen NPS account to the Treasury Bhiwani to convert it to a Government Employee NPS account. Due to non-creation of a Government Employee NPS account, my salary for the months of January and February 2025 is pending. I met Praveen, an employee of the Treasury Office Bhiwani, to get my Citizen NPS account converted to a Government Employee NPS account. Praveen told me to go to Pawan Kumar, Vashishtha CSC Centre Bhiwani, give him Rs. 700 and your work will be done. After this, when I told this to the employees posted with me, Charan Singh, Clerk, Rambilas, Clerk, they said that you talk to Praveen and get our NPS account also changed. After this I talked to Praveen who told me to give Rs. 2500 for all three to Pawan CSC Centre. Praveen Treasury Office Bhiwani is demanding Rs. 2500 from us as bribe through Pawan, CSC operator. We do not want to give Rs. 2500 as bribe to Praveen, an employee of Treasury Office, Bhiwani through Pawan CSC operator. If we do not give Rs. 2500 to Praveen, our Government Employee NPS account will not be created and our salary will not come in the account. Legal action be taken against Praveen, Treasury Office, Bhiwani and Pawan, Vashishth CSC operator, Bhiwani as per rules”.*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the present case, he has been falsely involved by concocted a story. In fact the petitioner had neither demanded nor accepted any bribe and it has been falsely alleged that Pawan Kumar, brother of the petitioner had allegedly accepted an amount of Rs.25,00/- as bribe from Pooja. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 12.03.2025 and challan has already been presented against him. He further submits that out of 32 witnesses, no witness has been examined so far. He further contends that the petitioner is a Government servant and there are no chances of fleeing from the process of justice. Moreover, the case is based on



the testimony of the complainant and certain official witnesses. Thus, the petitioner may not be in a position to influence the witnesses

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he is the main accused and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court. However, he admits that the petitioner is a first offender and was never involved in any other crime.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. In the present case, the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last four months and the investigation has been completed. Now, the case is listed today for framing of charge and the trial is not likely to conclude in near future. Thus, the further custody of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
