Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner would visit the Treasury Office, Sonipat on 05.02.2025 at 11.00 a.m. and furnish the requisite form.

[2] In turn, learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Raj Pal Singh, Chief Accounts Officer, Office of DSE, Haryana, Panchkula, submits that the Treasury Officer would accept the form submitted by the petitioner and would release the necessary benefits alongwith interest in her favour within a period of two weeks from today.

[3] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[5] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
