The present revision petition is directed against the order dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Court of learned Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari, vide which the application filed by the petitioner for preponing the date of hearing in the application under Section 12(1) of the Hindu Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 (for short the "1890 Act") was dismissed.

2. A petition under Sections 6 and 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 was filed by the petitioner against the respondent seeking custody of his two minor daughters and one minor son. Along with the said petition, an application under Section 12(1) of the 1890 Act (Annexure P-3) was filed seeking interim custody. The said application is stated to be fixed for arguments on 24.04.2025. An application for preponing the date of hearing was filed by the petitioner, which was dismissed vide the impugned order dated 11.03.2025 leading to the filing of the present revision petition.



3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the application for preponment and that the Court concerned may be directed to decide the application for interim custody.

4. The present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Court of learned Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rewari to look into the matter and make earnest efforts to hear and decide the application for interim custody in accordance with law expeditiously.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
