The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.482 dated 08.08.2024 registered under Sections 140(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Sections 137(2), 65, 3(5), 316(2) & 64(2) of BNS, 2023 and Sections 6 & 17 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 were added later on) at Police Station City, District Rohtak.

2. As per office report, notices issued to respondents No.2 & 3 have been duly served. However, no one has put in appearance on their behalf.
