1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner who is apprehending danger at the behest of respondent no.6 and also to direct respondent nos.4 and 5 not to harass and threaten him on the instructions of respondent no.6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a land dispute is pending before the Civil Courts at Ludhiana between the petitioner and respondent no.6, however, respondent no.6 is bent upon to take forcible possession of the land of the petitioner in connivance with respondent nos.4 and 5 and is continuously harassing and threatening him. The petitioner has submitted a complaint/representation dated 16.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondents no.2 & 3 but no action has been taken till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and grant him protection, if any threat to his life and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
