1. The instant petition has been filed for seeking 90% advance for the medical expenses to be incurred by the petitioner for the treatment of her son.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that on account of the exigency in medical condition, the son of the petitioner had to be taken to Dubai for administration of medicine and as such the present petition to the extent of seeking an advance has been rendered infructuous at this stage. The petitioner is, however, at liberty to file a fresh petition for seeking enforcement of her rights, if so advised, for the reimbursement of the expenses so occurred.
3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty as aforesaid.
