1 The petitioner has sought the relief for anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of FIR No.476 dated 25.11.2024 under Sections 190, 191(3), 115(2), 118(1), 324(2), 333, 351(2), 238 of BNS and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala, Haryana.

2 Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, has apprised the Court that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2025 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for any further investigation.

3 In view of the afore-said submission made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief, as extended to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 20.01.2025, is hereby made absolute.

4 However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 482(2) BNSS.
