1.            The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider his case for appointment to the post of Bus Driver/ Operator in Nagar Council-Nagar Panchayat in pursuance to the advertisement dated 28.01.2023.
2.            Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure P-7).
3.            Notice of motion.
4.            Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. AG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
5.            I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6.            In light of the facts of the case and statement given by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) within a period of
