1. The petitioner, who has no antecedents, has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 157 dated 25.04.2020, under Section 188 IPC and Sections 22 (C), 61, 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station, City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

2. The petitioner is in custody since the last about 04 years for an offence punishable under the NDPS Act, where

16000 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride were recovered jointly from all the co-accused, including the petitioner.

3. Solely because the petitioner is a woman, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner on bail, but with stringent conditions.

4. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions stipulated in Section 437 (3) Cr.P.C./Section 480 (3) of BNSS, 2023 and following condition:

(i) the petitioner shall plant 10 saplings of indigenous plants at a public place and submit proof in that regard by way of photographs before the trial court within a period of 15 days and if there is no such intimation submitted or intimation is found to be incorrect, then the State can move an application for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(ii) The petitioner will mark her attendance before the trial Court once in a fortnight till the trial concludes.

5. The petition stands allowed.
