**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. By invoking Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.209 dated 07.12.2022 registered under Sections 406 & 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Khanna City-2, Police District Khanna (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising thereof on the basis of compromise dated 29.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 08.04.2025, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court on 23.04.2025 for recording their statements with regard to the compromise. However, the parties did not appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording their statements. Thereafter, on 17.07.2025 on request made by learned counsel for the parties, one more opportunity was granted to the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court on 25.07.2025 for recording their statements qua compromise.
