1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant the subsistence/suspension allowance to the petitioner.
2. In compliance to the order passed by this Court on 03.07.2020, learned State counsel while referring to averments made in para 3 of the reply dated 20.07.2020 filed by way of affidavit of the Joint Member Secretary, Punjab Land Records Society, Jalandhar, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4, states that though there was no provision of payment of subsistence allowance in the appointment letter or non-disclosure agreement. Be that as it may, an amount of Rs.2,49,810/- was paid on account thereof vide Cheque No.000552 dated 17.07.2020 of HDFC Bank, on the basis of request made by the petitioner that he was not engaged in any profession, service or in any type of work and totally unemployed.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
