On 02.05.2025, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“On 10.12.2024, this Court has passed the following interim order:-*

*Learned State counsel submits that the appeal before the Collector is pending for 16.12.2024.*

*Accordingly, we adjourn the proceedings for 23.01.2025.*

*It is expected that the Appellate Authority shall make efforts to dispose of the appeal before the next date of hearing.*

*As per the spirit behind the afore-quoted order, by 23.01.2025, respondent No.2 should have finally disposed of or at least made earnest efforts to finally dispose of respondent No.6's appeal filed by him challenging therein the order dated 24.02.2021 passed by respondent No.3 but neither has been done.*

*Adjourned to 12.05.2025, on which date, respondent No.2 shall appear in person/through video conferencing to explain his afore conduct.”*

In terms of the afore quoted order of this Court, Mr.Uttam Singh, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Karnal has appeared in person through video conferencing and has also filed his affidavit dated 09.05.2025 to state that respondent No.6's appeal filed by him against the order dated 24.02.2021 passed by respondent No.3 has been dismissed by him on 09.05.2025. He also apologizes for the delay in the disposal of respondent No.6's appeal and assures this Court that in future the direction by this Court shall be complied with in letter and spirit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the final disposal of respondent No.6's appeal by the Deputy Commissioner, Karnal on 09.05.2025, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
