1. Additional affidavit of Himanshu Jain, Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana filed on behalf of the respondent has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record. Relevant para No.6 extracted therefrom is extracted hereinunder:-

*“6. That in compliance of the above reproduced order dated 09/07/2025 passed by this Hon’ble Court, the Executive Engineer, Panchayati Raj Public Works Division, Ludhiana, alongwith the Sarpanch, Village Development Officer, Junior Engineer and the Sub Divisional Officer, Panchayati Raj, Jagraon, had visited the spot in the village on 21/07/2025. After carrying out the necessary measurements at the spot in the village of the fields of the petitioner from which the pipeline carrying excess water from the fields of the petitioner to the intercepting drain, the total work to be done and the expenditure involved in carrying out the entire work was calculated as Rs.3,32,000/-. Thereafter, the Executive Engineer, Panchayati Raj Public Works Division, Ludhiana has submitted his report along with all the above stated documents to the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ludhiana vide his letter No. 02/03/2006 dated 24/07/2025. True translated copy of the said letter dated 24/07/2025 along with the detailed estimate prepared as well as the proposed plan for laying the pipeline for disposal of rain water from the fields of the petitioner is attached herewith as Annexure A-5.”*

2. In view thereof, petitioner, who is present in Court has handed over a cheque bearing No.803948 dated 30.07.2025 in a sum of Rs.3,32,000/- drawn at Indian Overseas Bank in favour of XEN (P.R.) Ludhiana to Sh. Mohandeep Singh, J.E., who is also present in Court.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions assures that process of laying down of pipes shall be initiated within four days from today and the same shall be concluded within a month thereafter.
4. In such circumstances, no cause survives in the instant petition. The same stands disposed of. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
5. Rule stands discharged.
