1. The petitioner has filed the present petition before this Court with a prayer to issue writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as several other similarly placed employees have already been regularized by the respondents. It has been further prayed that the respondents may be directed to take effective and conscious decision regarding the increase in salary as per the Government Policy for contractual employees dated 19.01.2024 (Annexure P-15).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted two representations (Annexures P-17 and P-18), claiming the same relief but no decision has been conveyed to the petitioner so far. She further contends that at this stage, the petitioner shall be satisfied in case the appropriate

directions are issued to the respondent No. 1 to decide the representations (Annexure P-17 and P-18) in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. In the present case, it is an admitted fact that two representations (Annexures P-17 and P-18) are stated to be pending with respondent No. 1, which were submitted by the petitioner claiming similar relief. Consequently, respondent No. 1 is directed to examine the representations (Annexures P-17 and P-18) and to pass a speaking and well reasoned order within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. It is expected that the respondent No. 1 shall take into account all the relevant rules/instructions/policies before passing the speaking order.

8. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
