1. The present two Regular Second Appeals arise from the common judgment passed in Civil Suit filed in the year 1989 by Harbans Lal.
2. RSA-1548-1997 has been filed by the State of Haryana whereas RSA-1825-1997 has been filed by Harbans Lal.
3. On 02.06.1997, in the RSA filed by the State of Haryana, the judgment and decree passed by the Appellate Court on 14.01.1997 was ordered to be stayed.
4. None had appeared on behalf of the respondent in RSA-1548-1997 and for the appellant in RSA-1825-1997 on the last date and accordingly, notice was issued.
5. In spite of the notice having been issued, none has appeared on behalf of the said Harbans Lal.
6. Learned State counsel has submitted that in the recent past, the respondent has not approached the concerned Department to get the



implementation of the judgment of the First Appellate Court and thus, the present appeals be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the State to revive the case, in case, the respondent- Harbans Lal or any person on his behalf approaches the concerned Department for implementation of the judgment of the First Appellate Court.

7. In view of the above, present appeals are disposed of at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.

8. Liberty is also granted to the said Harbans Lal to revive the appeals, in case, any cause of action survives.
