The petitioner had earlier also accessed this Court on the same cause of action, through his filing CWP-8615-2024, however, the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, through drawing the order dated 19.04.2024, disposed of the said writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.

3. However, instead of taking recourse to the alternative statutory remedy, the petitioner has instituted the present writ petition again on the same cause of action, which is not maintainable.
