Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus thereby holding and directing that petitioners are entitled to re-fixation of their seniority in the 1997 batch of Veterinary Surgeons at par with additional candidates and further giving the deemed date benefits of 3rd ACP w.e.f. 01.01.2016 at par with juniors (private respondents) and extend all consequential service benefits.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to their grievance, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 04.06.2025 (Annexure P-11) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 04.06.2025 (Annexure P-11) served by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.
