The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is under imminent danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 14.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who has produced a speaking order passed by SHO, Police Station Sadar Sangrur, dated 18.06.2025. As per the said order, the statement of respondent No.4, Jaspal Singh, has been recorded, wherein he stated that the petitioners were married with mutual consent and that he has no objection to their marriage. He further assured that neither he nor his family members will interfere in the

lives of the petitioners. A copy of the speaking order has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is accepted.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
