The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS in case bearing FIR No.132 dated 05.12.2024 registered under Section 13-A of the Punjab Gambling Act and 7(3) of the Lotteries (Regulation) Act at Police Station Division No.3, Police Commissionerate, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.02.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 10.02.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482 BNSS.
