The applicant-wife has filed the present application for seeking transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/64/2023, titled '*Amit Kumar Vs. Harpreet Thakur*', filed by the respondent-husband, pending in the Family Court, Rupnagar and she seeks transfer of the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala.

In pursuance of the notice issued, respondent made appearance through counsel. The counsel for the respondent submits that he does not intend to file reply, as he has specific instructions on behalf of the respondent-Amit Kumar that he has no objection, if the application is accepted and the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, is transferred from Rupnagar to Patiala.

Heard.

It is submitted by the counsel for the applicant that there are two

children, born from the wedlock of the parties to the lis, who are presently in the care and custody of the applicant. Also, it is submitted that the applicant has filed the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is also pending in the Courts at Patiala.

In view of the aforesaid submissions and also considering the statement made by the counsel for the respondent, the transfer application is allowed and the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act i.e. HMA/64/2023, titled '*Amit Kumar Vs. Harpreet Thakur*', filed by the respondent-husband, stands transferred from the Family Court, Rupnagar, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patiala. The requisite record of the aforesaid case be sent by the Family Court, Rupnagar, to the District and Sessions Judge, Patiala.

Learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala, shall assign the said petition to the Family Court, Patiala. Even, the parties are directed to appear before the Family Court, Patiala, within a period of one month from today onwards.
