Instant petition has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act') for appointment of an Arbitrator.

2. Mr. Puran Singh Rana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and has filed his memorandum of appearance.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that an agreement dated 31.03.2003 was entered between the parties, which was renewed on 29.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) for another period of 10 years. He submits that a dispute has arisen between the parties and concededly, no notice under Section 21 of the Act has been served on the respondent before preferring the instant petition.

4. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one after availing the procedure prescribed under the Act.
