This writ petition has been filed under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction particularly a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents vide which the petitioner who is working on the post of ward attendant which is a group D employee post retiring at the age of 58 years instead of 60 years which is against the rule 143 of Haryana civil service general rules, 2016 vide which the retiring age of group D is 60 years and also against the judgment dated 24.01.2024 (P-4) passed by this Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 2331 of 2023 title as Rumali Devi and others vs State of Haryana and others.

2. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 26.08.2025 (Annexure P- 3) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the representation dated 26.08.2025 (Annexure P- 3) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 26.08.2025 (Annexure P- 3) after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.
7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
