1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.0086 dated 02.04.2025, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC (Sections 318(4), 61(2) of BNS and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Act added later on), at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
