Applicant-respondent no.1 seeks review of decision dated 27.11.2024 passed in CWP-14736-2024, whereby order dated 24.09.2019 passed by the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Chandigarh was quashed and set aside.

Having heard learned counsel, in our considered opinion, learned counsel for applicant-respondent no.1 merely seeks to reargue the matter afresh. He is unable to point out any error apparent on the face of it or any other ground which calls for review of decision dated 27.11.2024. It is a settled position that Court's jurisdiction to review its judgement is limited and has to be exercised within the framework of Section 114 read with Order 47 CPC.
