On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the parties submit that they are not in touch with their clients and accordingly, notice be issued to them.

Let notice be issued to the parties to the instant appeal for 25.02.2025.”

2. As per the report of the Registry, notice issued to the appellant received back unserved with the report that no such person is residing at the given address. Respondents No.1 and 2 are stated to have expired.
