1. On 19.05.2025, this Court had been pleased to pass the following order:-

*“Present: Mr. Ashish Gupta, Advocate
for the petitioners.*

Inter alia, contends that in the present case, the decree was passed on 23.03.2017 for Rs.2,43,000/- alongwith interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the suit till its realization. It is submitted that the petitioners are ready to deposit an amount of Rs.3,00,000- before the Executing Court on or before 07.07.2025 and the said amount be released to the respondents/plaintiffs after taking surety from them. It is further submitted that in case the appeal of the petitioners is allowed and the suit filed by the plaintiffs/respondents is dismissed, then, the said amount be returned to the petitioners.

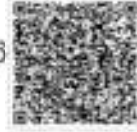
