HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 & 2-PSPCL, on instructions, submits that in case the petitioner clears the arrear directly with the respondent-Department, two tube-well / water connection of the area concerned shall be continued the supply of electricity.

[2] In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that in case the bills are directly sent to the office of petitioner-Society, the same shall be cleared within the time stipulated therein.

[3] In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is **disposed off**.

[4] It is made clear that the parties shall be bound by their respective statements.

[5] At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner though raises an objection that from the same two tube-well, the builder has been providing water connection to private developer and for that, the petitioner-Society is being charged; in this regard, in the humble opinion of this Court, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail its remedy in accordance with law.

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
