at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure. A copy of Receipt of costs of Rs. 10,000/- has been placed on record in compliance of the order dated 18.12.2024.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 do not oppose the compromise having been effected between the parties.

4. In view of the report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondents have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 116 dated 12.09.2024 under Sections 332, 125, 79, 324 (1) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
