**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.**

The present appeal has been preferred against the judgment dated 14.07.2025 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Sirsa in case bearing FIR No.19 dated 04.02.2025 registered under Sections 110, 115, 117(2), 190, 191(2), 191(3), 324(4), 333, 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and Section 3(1)(R)(S) of SC/ST Act at Police Station Rori, Sirsa, dismissing the bail petition of the appellants.

2. The learned counsel for the appellants contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties as is evident from the affidavit/compromise dated 27.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) and therefore, bail be granted to the appellants.

3. The learned counsel for the State on the other hand, contends that serious allegations have been levelled against the appellants and therefore, the appellants are not entitled to the concession of bail. He, however, admits the factum of a compromise as also the period of custody undergone by the appellants who are incarcerated since 07.02.2025 respectively.

4. Mr. Balraj Singh Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his Memorandum of Appearance. The same is taken on record. He admits the factum of a compromise and states that the complainant has no objection, if the appellants are granted the concession of bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. Keeping view the factum of compromise as also the period of custody undergone by the appellants who are incarcerated since 07.02.2025 respectively, the present appeal is allowed and the appellants are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
