Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48521-2024 titled as “Rakesh Kumar vs. *State of Haryana and others*” vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction “...to respondent No.2–Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gharaunda, District Karnal, to look into the complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within one month from today.”
