1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel contends that the Contempt Petition was filed for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders Annexure P/1 dated 29.10.2020, in CWP-18010-2020, to decide representation dated 06.10.2020, submitted by the petitioner within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, but in view of order dated 12.01.2021, having been supplied to him by the learned State Counsel in the morning, he may be permitted to withdraw the Contempt Petition with liberty to challenge order dated 12.01.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In the light of the position as noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
