**HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)**

1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the payment stands released in favour of the petitioner.
2. To this effect, learned counsel for the petitioner raises dispute with respect to certain amount still outstanding, for which, he seeks liberty to file representation.
3. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner moves representation with respect to outstanding amount before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks, the same shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order

thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to each of the petitioners from his / her own pocket.
