The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.74, dated 20.06.2024, under Section 21(b) of NDPS Act (Section 29, Section 61 and Section 85 of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.01.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
