1. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the amount for which the petitioner was entitled for has already been released and only grievance which survives as of now is for the grant of the interest on the delayed release of the said benefits and the petitioner is also aggrieved against an order re-fixing the salary. Learned counsel further submits that the liberty be given to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation so as to claim interest on the delayed release of the said pensionary benefits and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner raising any grievance, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such



representation and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
